

REBA PEER-TO-PEER MENTORING PROGRAM

Objective

REBA's pioneering Mentoring Program is intended to assist members who are new to the practice of real estate law. It is intended to be flexible and informal, and to develop collegiality between the participants. Any REBA lawyer member is welcome to serve as a real estate mentor or sign up to become a mentee. REBA mentors are experienced real estate lawyers who are committed to providing newer lawyers with guidance to help them in their professional development.

Guidelines & Process

The REBA program administrator will pair lawyers based on their professional interests and geographical proximity of their practices. Once paired, the parties may network and communicate as they choose (*i.e. phone, email or occasional meetings*). Matches are for a period of six months. Mentors are available to discuss real estate related matters, and to provide guidance.
